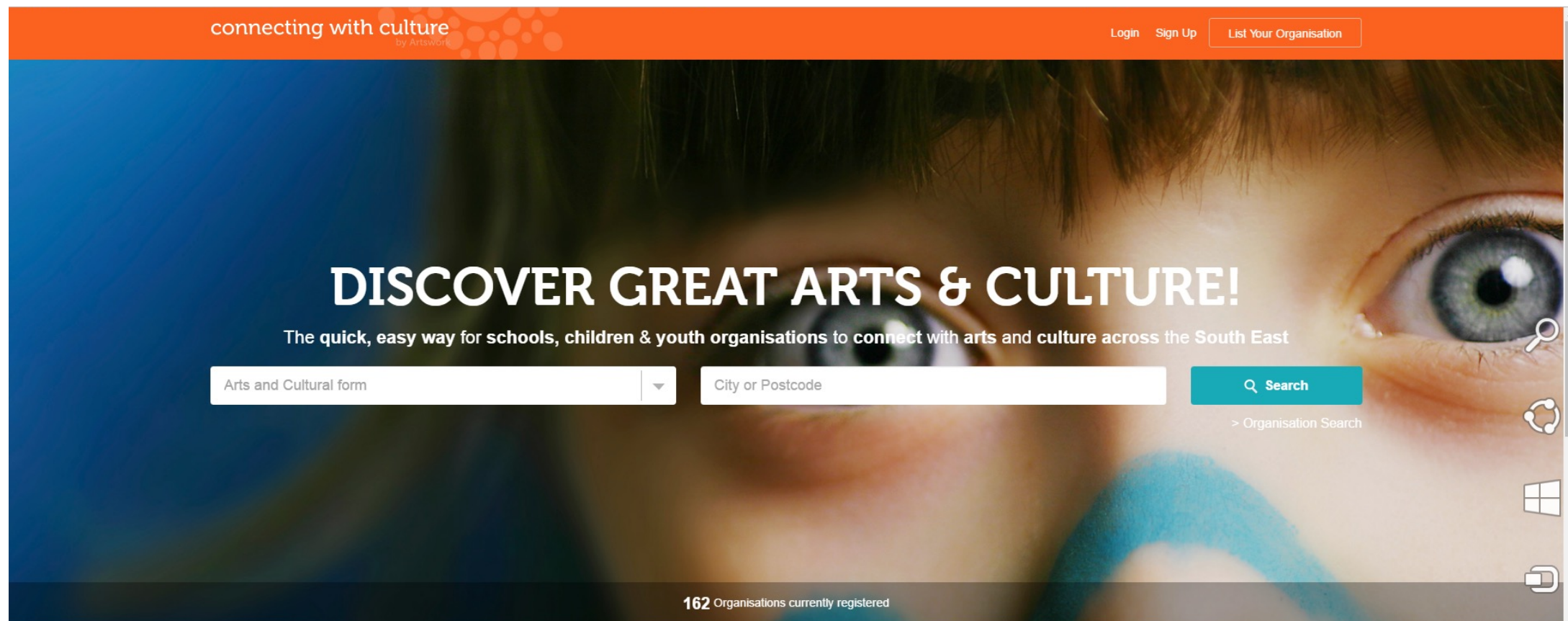

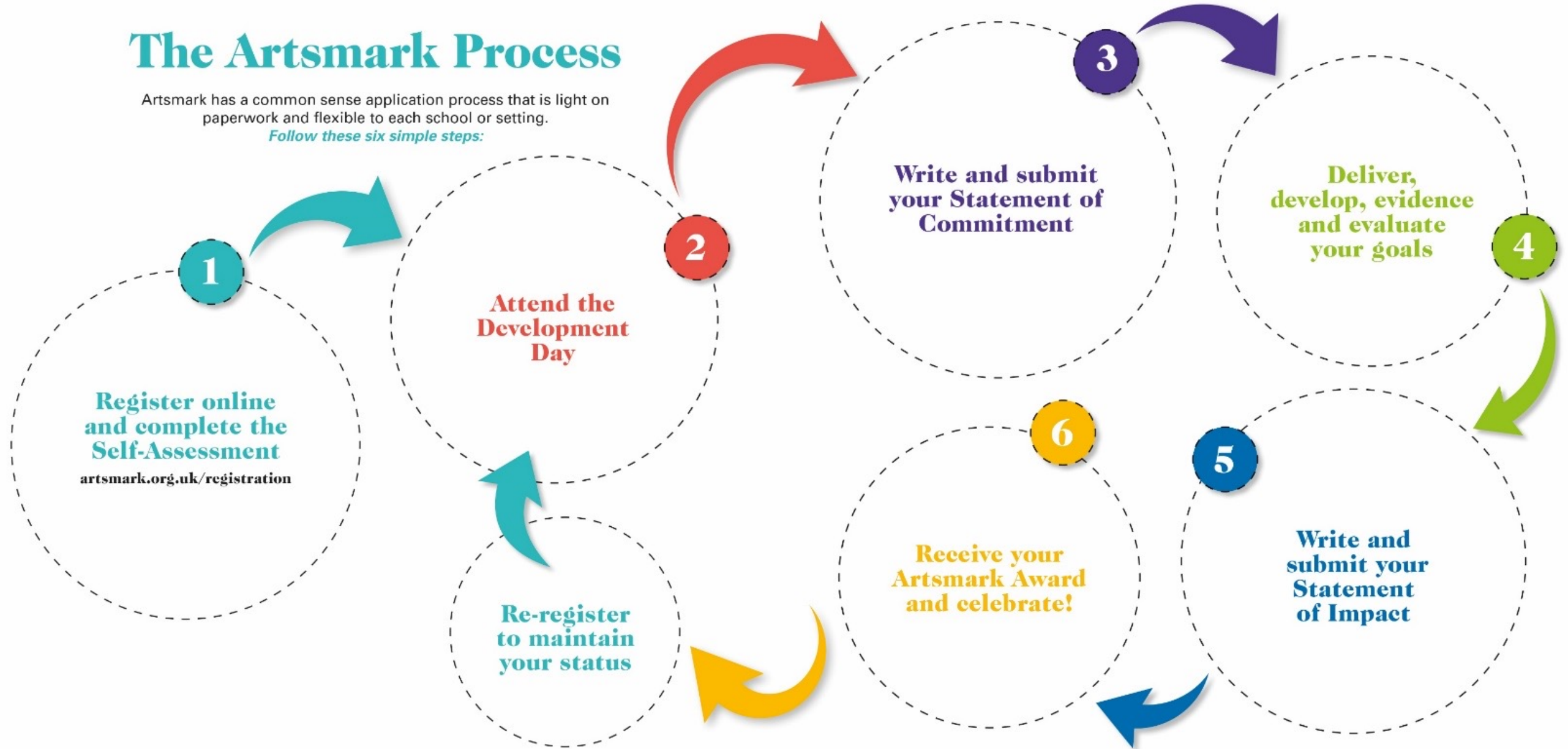
- is the only creative quality standard for schools and education settings, accredited by Arts Council England.

The Artsmark Process

Artsmark has a common sense application process that is light on paperwork and flexible to each school or setting.

Follow these six simple steps:



Arts Award

- Is a qualification at 5 levels that enables children and young people to explore arts and culture as both artist and consumer
- Gold Arts Award is a Level 3 qualification with 16 UCAS points attached
- Artswork provides additional training to support teachers once trained as Arts Award advisors and mentoring for new advisors

Funding currently available for Advisor Training for Discover and Explore Level for limited numbers of teachers.
