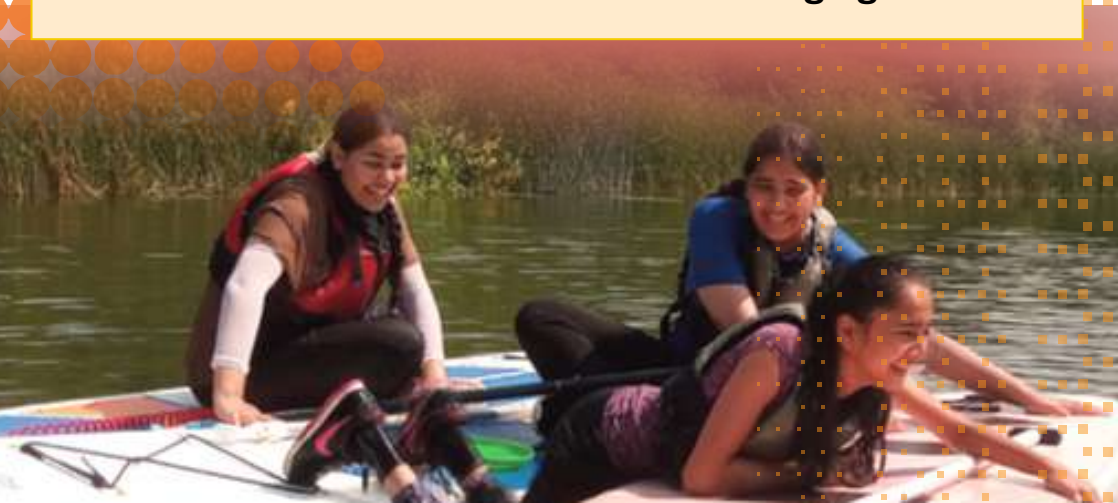
Slough Holiday Activities and Food Programme (HAF)
